



Please review the following prior to a fungal investigation by RestCon Environmental.

## Before Your Fungal Investigation

- Do not schedule indoor maintenance, cleaning service, or perform cleaning activities before the inspection. Please discuss with your consultant for how long.
- Do not disturb areas of visible fungal growth. During the inspection, we will want to observe the problem areas as they are. This can lead to important clues about mold sources.
- Crawlspace and/or attics are typically not inspected during an initial inspection. The purpose of the initial inspection is to determine what types and quantities of organisms are present in the living space. Attic and crawlspace inspections may be recommended following a review of the initial inspection results.

## The Day Before Your Fungal Investigation

- The day before the inspection you will be contacted by your Indoor Environmental Consultant to confirm your appointment and answer any pre-inspection questions you may have.
- Ideally, you should close all doors and windows for a minimum of 12 hours prior to the inspection. Outdoor air may dilute indoor air levels of musty odors. Doors may be opened while entering or exiting but should not be left standing open. If you have any questions, please ask your consultant.
- Air purifiers should be turned off for a minimum of 12 hours prior to the inspection.

## The Day of Your Fungal Investigation

- Power should be on. Notify the office in advance if power is not available.
- We would like to be able to smell odors as we inspect your home. Please avoid cooking strong smelling foods, including brewing coffee (take-out or instant coffee is okay). Avoid air fresheners, scented fabric softeners, dryer sheets, burning candles, and essential oils.
